WWF Press Conference Will COP28 deliver on nature?

The science is clear that the world will not be able to limit global warming to 1.5C and adapt to the impacts of the climate crisis without taking action to protect and restore nature. Yet, despite nature featuring strongly outside of the formal negotiations, both nature and food systems - a key driver of biodiversity loss - are currently not strongly included in the draft text of COP28's pivotal Global Stocktake and the food talks have failed to deliver any agreement.
